RE: JOINING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2026/2027

I am pleased to inform that your application to join School of Library, Archives and Documentation Studies (SLADS) was successful and you have been selected to pursue Basic Technician Certificate course (*One year*) and then Ordinary Diploma course (*Two years*). You will report at selected Campus to pursue your studies for the academic year(s) scheduled to commence on **19th October 2026**.

Being a form IV leaver, the duration of your course is three years. This course requires a minimum of 360 credit hours to complete and is divided into three levels, NTA 4, 5 and 6 having 120 credit hours each. Please note that each level has two semesters and it is independent by itself. After successful completion of NTA level 4 (*two semesters*), a student shall be awarded **Basic Technician Certificate**; on the other hand after successful completion of NTA level 5 (*two semesters*), a student shall be awarded **Technician Certificate** and after successful completion of NTA level 6 (*two semesters*) a student shall be awarded an **Ordinary Diploma** in the respective area of study.

The School is fully registered by the National Council for Technical and Vocational Education and Training (NACTVET) and all students are required to be registered by the Council and comply with required statutory guidelines, rules and regulations as issued by NACTVET. (*Procedures and regulations will be distributed to all students during orientation week*).

1. COURSE STRUCTURE

NACTVET accredited courses are linked to the National Technical Awards (NTA). It should be noted that, all Form Four must be holders of Certificates of Secondary School – CSEE and should start at NTA level 4, while Form Six (i.e. holders of Advanced Certificate of Secondary School - ACSEE) should start at NTA level 5.

2. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

The opening date of the School for first semester shall be on **19th October 2026**. Before registration, **you will be required to pay all the required fees. Registration will take place for one (1) week from 19th10/2026 to 30th10/2026. You are strongly encouraged to register within registration week to avoid inconveniences. Classes begins from 02th November, 2026.**

Please note that the fee for NTA level 4 is TZS 590,000/=, NTA level 5 course fees is TZS.880,00/= and that of NTA 6 is 880,000/=per annum. However, arrangements can be made to pay by installments as follows:-

3. REGISTRATION STATUS

The Candidate will be required to register for the programme offered to him/her by producing the following:

- i. Present:
 - a. Relevant original certificates of secondary Education C.S.E.E /A.C.S.E. E or the equivalent;
 - b. Original NTA level 4 Certificates and Transcripts or equivalent (recognized by NACTVET) for those applying NTA level 5 using C.S.E.E and Basic Technician Certificate qualification;
 - c. Other relevant certificates from recognized training institutions and
 - d. Birth certificate or affidavit.
- ii. Bring two photographs (Stamp Size)
- iii. Bring your own stationery and writing materials
- iv. Proof of payment of the required fees and
- v. **NHIF Medical insurance Identification card** (*applicable to employees and defendants*)
- vi. **National Identification Authority (NIDA)**

4. ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS

- 4.1. **Accommodation:** It is the responsibility of the students to cater for their own accommodation. For candidates interested to study at Bagamoyo Campus, there are hostels organized by Students Organization (SLADSSO). Students are encouraged to live in these hostels for suitable learning environment and safety. Contact Details: 0762784159/0741673186/0620688805. For those who will live in hostels you are advised to bring with you the following things for hostel use:- Bucket, pillow and pillow cases, bed sheets, towels, mosquito net, mattress 3" x 6", canvas shoes and T-shirts for sports.
- 4.2. **Meal:** It should also be noted that it is the responsibility of the sponsor / parent / guardian to provide meal allowances for their students. Students can also arrange their own cooking facilities. Caterers are available at nearby School and hostels.

5. FIELD AND PRACTICAL WORK ATTACHMENT

Field practical work is compulsory for NTA 4 AND 5 students and it forms part of the final examinations. Parent/guardian or Sponsors will be responsible for providing financial assistance for 6 weeks at the prevailing rate plus return travel costs to a destination within Tanzania.

Every student should submit his/her budget to the Parent/guardian or sponsor well in advance so that the agreed fund is available at the right time.

6. MEDICAL EXPENSES

Medical expenses and personal liabilities are not covered by the School. It is advised that sponsors and parents provide Medical insurance for their staff/student. NHIF is recommended.

7. RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 7.1. Students admitted into the School are expected to abide to the rules and regulations governing the School. A student shall be dismissed from studies or face other disciplinary actions stipulated in the School rules and regulations if he/she is involved in misconducts as indicated into Students By-Laws and Prospectus.
- 7.2. Students are encouraged to wear suits (black and dark blue, with white shirt and light blue shirts) however students are expected to put on descent clothes while at the School. Jeans, Tight or hanging trousers (mlegezo), skintight, transparent/backless, excessive slit (mpasuo), min -skirts, earrings and plaintiff for men are not allowed.

8. HOW TO GET TO SLADS

8.1. Bagamoyo Campus

The school is located at UKUNI along the Dar es Salaam - Bagamoyo Road, two kilometers from Bagamoyo Bus Stand. There are daily public bus services shuttling between Dar es Salaam and Bagamoyo.

8.2 Dar es Salaam Campus

Dar es Salaam Campus is located at National Central Library buildings (Maktaba Kuu ya Taifa) along Bibi Titi Mohamed Road near the Kisutu Court.
